Pictures of Levers and Fulcrums

A seesaw is an example of a lever. Draw a pencil sketch of two people on a seesaw. Label the fulcrum.

Levers can be used to move heavy objects. Draw a pencil sketch of a person moving a heavy rock with a lever. Draw and label the fulcrum.

A broom is a lever. The hand that holds the top of the broom is the fixed point that doesn't move. Draw a pencil sketch of a person sweeping the floor. Label the fulcrum.

A pair of scissors is made up of two levers that are attached to each other. Draw a pencil sketch of a pair of scissors. Label the fulcrum.
